
The Mission of the **National & Diocese of Superior's CCW**

The Mission of the **Seven Sisters Apostolate**

- ▶ The Seven Sisters Apostolate is ***a call to strengthen the Church*** by ensuring that a Holy Hour is prayed each day of the week for the sole intention of a specific priest or bishop—a “holy wasting” (cf. Mt. 26:10) or lavishing of prayer for his deeper conformity to Christ.

How do we Get Started?

➤ Seven Women

- From among the cluster of parishes served by your Pastor
- All ages, any state in life – discern possibly the call to be a substitute or assistant if weekly commitment isn't possible
- Seven days of the week divided among the Seven Sisters; co-adorers can share the weekly commitment

➤ One anchoress

- Communicates & Coordinates with the priest and among the committed Seven Sisters



How do we Get Started?

► One Hour of Prayer Each Week

- Hour is to be solely focused on your priest – for his perseverance, for his intentions, for his devotion to *Mary*.
- The hour is intended to be prayed in front of the Eucharist, exposed when possible. Can be prayed in another church when travelling or from anywhere as an exception to the norm.
- Commitment to the Holy Hour is for one year
